		ADMISSIONS REGULATIONS 2024 Master Studies in English	Approved by the Senate Date: 27.02.2024

I. GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Romanian citizens as well as the EU/EEA citizens, Swiss Confederation citizens and non-UE citizens** can apply for enrolment at this program according to the laws in force.
- The deadline for uploading documents to the online admission platform aligns with the admission contest schedule.

II. **CANDIDATES** intending to enroll in master's programs taught in English are required to submit an **APPLICATION FILE** to the Admission Office of the Faculty¹ administering these programs by uploading the following documents in PDF format to the online admission platform at admitere.usamv.ro:

II.A. for **Romanian candidates**:

- ✓ **Application form**;
- ✓ **Diplomas** (Certificates of graduation for graduates of 2024, reflecting the diploma exam grade and the average grades from the study years);
- ✓ **Diploma Supplements/Transcript of records**
- ✓ **Baccalaureate diploma**
- ✓ **Birth certificate**;
- ✓ **Identity card**;
- ✓ **Four (4) photos passport size** (*For online admissions, these must be submitted within 10 days of the start of the academic year 2024-2025);
- ✓ **Medical certificate** confirming that applicants are fit for the field of study or program they are applying to.
- ✓ **Documents to certify the knowledge of English language**, minimum level B1;

II.B. for **UE/SEE citizens, non-EU foreign citizens, or Romanian citizens residing abroad**:

- ✓ **Application form**;
- ✓ **Bachelor's degree diploma or its equivalent** - with apostilled translation into Romanian (if applicable) into Romanian, English;
- ✓ **Diploma Supplements/ Transcripts of records** - with apostilled translation into Romanian (if applicable) into Romanian, English;
- ✓ **Baccalaureate Graduation Diploma or equivalent** - with apostilled translation into Romanian (if applicable) into Romanian, English;
- ✓ **Transcript of records** for all years of study in secondary education - with apostilled translation into Romanian (if applicable) into Romanian, English;
- ✓ **Birth certificate** - with apostilled translation into Romanian (if applicable) into Romanian, English;
- ✓ **Application for obtaining a letter of acceptance to study for non-EU citizens**; the required documents to obtain this document will be sent to the Ministry of Education in Romania — International Relations Department (www.edu.ro) by UASVM Bucharest;
- ✓ **Certificate of recognition of high school studies** for candidates who are citizens of the EU, EEA, or the Swiss Confederation;
- ✓ **Passport (for non-EU citizens) or identity card (for EU citizens)**, to clearly see the photo, the issuing date and the validity period;
- ✓ **Four (4) photos passport size** (*For online admissions, these must be submitted within 10 days of the start of the academic year 2024-2025);
- ✓ **Medical certificate** certifying that applicants are suitable for the field of study or program they are applying for, in Romanian/English;
- ✓ **Documents certifying English language proficiency**, minimum level B1.

III. FINAL EVALUATION OF CANDIDATES

The final grade for Romanian citizens and EU/EEA citizens will be calculated according to Annex 4 of the regulations regarding the organization of the admission competition for the academic year 2024-2025, as a weighted average between:

- The average of the undergraduate study years²;
- Essay.

Non-Eu citizens (SELF-FUNDED) will apply for fee-paying seats established by the Ministry of Education at the request of USAMV Bucharest, and admission will be based on descending order of the average of undergraduate study years.

IV. THE RANKING OF CANDIDATES

IV.1. When multiple candidates have the same average as the candidate in the last allocated spot on the initial lists for funded or fee-paying places, the candidate with the highest essay score will be ADMITTED.

IV.2. If the equality persists, it will be declared ADMITTED the candidate with the highest average of years of undergraduate studies.
